


PILL BOTTLES


Joan White is still collecting empty medicine/pill bottles.


The Women's Group has put together more bags to take and give to someone that is in need of some hygiene products, snacks and etc...

BROCCOLI SALAD

4 c. fresh broccoli, cut up

1/4 c. chopped onions

1/4 c. steamed raisins, cooled

8 slices bacon, chopped

DRESSING

3/4 c. mayonnaise

½ c. sugar

3 tsp. vinegar

Mix all of the above ingredients.



CRAN-RASPBERRY SALAD by Eleanor Schultz

1 (3oz pkg.) raspberry Jello

3/4 c. boiling water

1 can cran-raspberry sauce

1 sm. can crushed pineapple, drained

½ banana, sliced

½ c. chopped nuts

3 oz. pkg. cream cheese, softened


1/4 c. mayonnaise

1 c. Cool Whip

Dissolve Jello in boiling water. Stir in cranraspberry sauce which has been broken up with a fork. When cool add the fruits. Combine cream cheese and mayonnaise until smooth and add Cool Whip. Fold into Jello mixture, pour into a mold and chill until set.
