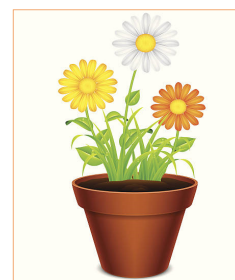

BROCCOLI SALAD

4 c. fresh broccoli, cut up

¼ c. chopped onions

¼ c. steamed raisins, cooled

8 slices bacon, chopped

DRESSING

¾ c. mayonnaise

¼ c. sugar

3 tsp. vinegar

Mix all of the above ingredients.



CRAN-RASPBERRY SALAD

1 (3oz pkg.) raspberry Jello

¾ c. boiling water

1 can cran-raspberry sauce

1 sm. can crushed pineapple, drained

½ banana, sliced

½ c. chopped nuts

3 oz. pkg. cream cheese, softened

¼ c. mayonnaise

1 c. Cool Whip

Dissolve Jello in boiling water. Stir in cran-raspberry sauce which has been broken up with a fork. When cool add the fruits. Combine cream cheese and mayonnaise until smooth and add Cool Whip. Fold into Jello mixture, pour into a mold and chill until set.
