Scripture reading John 3: 16, Romans 10: 10-13, Philippians 2:5-12

John 3: 16

“For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not perish but may have eternal life.

Romans 10: 10-13

10 For one believes with the heart, leading to righteousness, and one confesses with the mouth, leading to salvation. 11 The scripture says, “No one who believes in him will be put to shame.” 12 For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek; the same Lord is Lord of all and is generous to all who call on him. 13 For “everyone who calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved.”

Philippians 2:5-12

5 Let the same mind be in you that was in Christ Jesus,
6 who, though he existed in the form of God,
 did not regard equality with God
 as something to be grasped,
7 but emptied himself,
 taking the form of a slave,
 assuming human likeness.
And being found in appearance as a human,
8 he humbled himself
 and became obedient to the point of death—
 even death on a cross.
9 Therefore God exalted him even more highly
 and gave him the name
 that is above every other name,
10 so that at the name given to Jesus
 every knee should bend,
 in heaven and on earth and under the earth,
11 and every tongue should confess
 that Jesus Christ is Lord,
