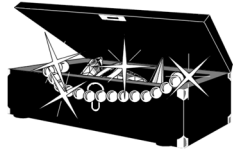

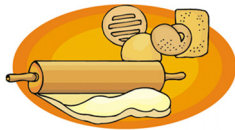


Bazaar Jewelry Needed
